

JUDGES REQUIREMENTS

REGIONAL PDI JUDGE melr5/10/10

1. Applicant must be a regular member of the USPCA
2. Applicant must submit a resume showing a minimum of three (3) years experience as a police K-9 handler. Applicant must have handled or trained a police service dog that has obtained a PDI title in a recorded sanctioned USPCA certification trial.
3. Applicant must have judged a minimum of three (3) regional certifications in not less than a 2-year period, covering all phases of obedience, agility, article search, box search and criminal apprehension.
4. A total of not less than thirty-five (35) K9 teams must be judged over this period in each phase.
5. The Regional Executive board will review the application and approve or disapprove it. The Regional President and one other Regional Officer must sign the application. The application must then be forwarded to the Judges Committee Chairman and a copy to the National Director. This must be done 60 days prior to the next scheduled Executive Board Meeting.
6. The committee will review the application and make a recommendation to the National Executive Board, who will approve or disapprove the application. If approved, the applicant will receive a Regional Certified Judge Certificate.

JUDGES REQUIREMENTS

REGIONAL PDII TRACKING JUDGE melr5/10/10

1. Applicant must be a regular member of the USPCA
2. Applicant must submit a resume showing a minimum of three (3) years experience as a police K-9 handler. Applicant must have handled or trained a police service dog that has obtained a PDII or PDIIX certification in a recorded sanctioned USPCA certification trial.
3. Applicant must have judged a minimum of two (2) regional certifications in not less than a 2-year period.
4. A total of not less than ten (10) K9 teams must be judged over this period.
5. The Regional Executive board will review the application and approve or disapprove it. The Regional President and one other Regional Officer must sign the application. The application must then be forwarded to the Judges Committee Chairman and a copy to the National Director. This must be done 60 days prior to the next scheduled Executive Board Meeting.
6. The committee will review the application and make a recommendation to the National Executive Board, who will approve or disapprove the application. If approved, the applicant will receive a Regional Certified Judge Certificate.

JUDGES REQUIREMENTS

REGIONAL DETECTOR JUDGE melr5/10/10

1. Applicant must be a regular member of the USPCA
2. Applicant must submit a resume showing a minimum of three (3) years experience as a police K-9 handler. Applicant must have handled or trained a police service dog that has obtained a detector certificate of certification in a recorded sanctioned USPCA certification trial.
3. Applicant must have judged a minimum of three (3) regional certifications in not less than a 2-year period, covering both rooms and vehicles.
4. A total of not less than thirty-five (35) K9 teams must be judged over this period in each phase.
5. The Regional Executive board will review the application and approve or disapprove it. The Regional President and one other Regional Officer must sign the application. The application must then be forwarded to the Judges Committee Chairman and a copy to the National Director. This must be done 60 days prior to the next scheduled Executive Board Meeting.
6. The committee will review the application and make a recommendation to the National Executive Board, who will approve or disapprove the application. If approved, the applicant will receive a Regional Certified Judge Certificate.
