

CAN I CHIEF JUDGE A REGIONAL DETECTOR TRIAL?

If you check any of the below boxes, you are qualified to be a regional Detector Chief Judge. Just remember you still must have your application into the National Secretary by Jan 31st of each year, and you must judge or Chief Judge a Detection trial at least once every two years. *(Explosive Chief Judges must have been a handler or trainer of an explosive dog, or attended a USPCA sanctioned Bomb training course)*

Option 1

I am a Nationally or Regionally Certified Detector Judge and a Level I or greater certified Trainer or certified Detector Trainer. You do not need to return this form.

Option 2

I am a Nationally or Regionally Certified Detector Judge and meet these additional requirements:

I have 10 years' experience as a Detector dog handler

AND

I have certified a dog in a USPCA Detector trial at least 6 times.

If your check mark is beside the second option, then you are required to return this form, signed by you, with copies of 6 certificates of certification for Detection work or the dates and locations that you certified Detection with a dog. You will only need to do this once as long as your membership remains current.
