

# CAN I CHIEF JUDGE A TRACKING TRIAL?

If you check any of the below boxes, you are qualified to be a Tracking Trial Chief Judge. Just remember you still must have your application into the National Secretary by Jan 31<sup>st</sup> of each year, and you must judge or Chief Judge a tracking trial at least once every two years.

## Option 1

I am a Regionally Certified Tracking Judge and a Level I or greater certified Trainer. If you checked this box, you do not need to return this form.

## Option 2

I am a Regionally Certified Tracking Judge and meet these additional requirements:

I have 10 years' experience as a tracking dog handler

AND

I have certified a dog in a USPCA Tracking trial at least 6 times.

If your check mark is beside the second option, then you are required to return this form, signed by you, with copies of 6 certificates of certification for Tracking or the dates and locations that you certified Tracking with a dog. You will only need to do this once as long as your membership remains current.
