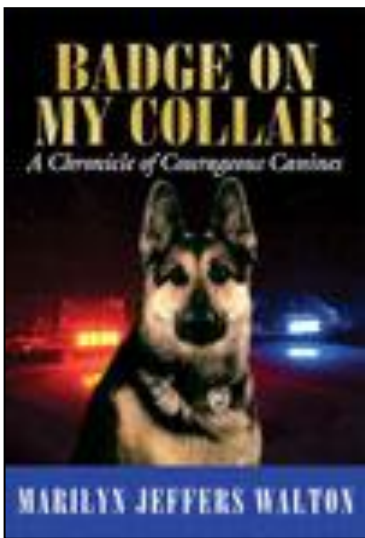


## **TWO GREAT BOOKS**

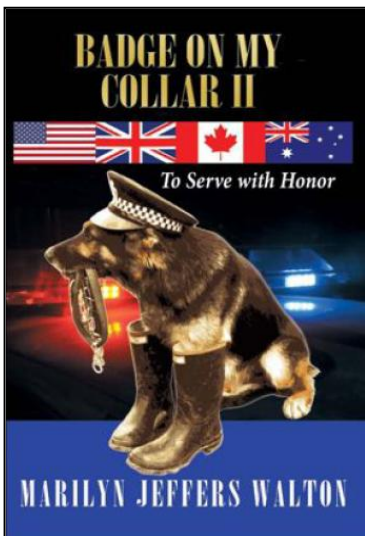

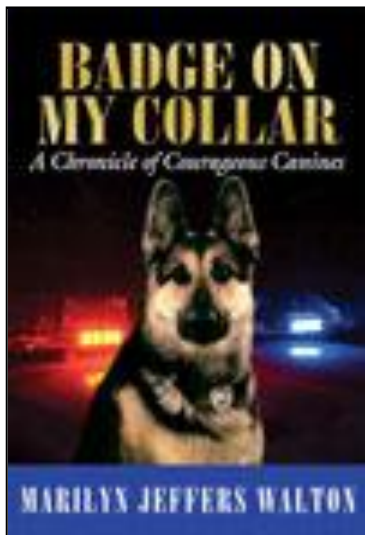
