This book traces the history of the USPCA from the first K-9 competition in Jacksonville Beach, Florida, in 1964, until today.

It is a compilation of information from the dedicated officers that first saw the wonderful capabilities of a cop's best friend, the police service dog. These visionary officers saw a unique partnership and asset to law enforcement, but knew without proper training and utilization that the partnership may have never survived. Indeed, many of the trained police service dog programs of today would never have survived those early years of improper training and use.

The goal of this publication is to document that history and the part that many heretofore unrecognized individuals and the USPCA have played in canines' development.

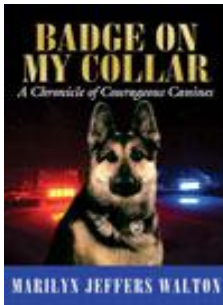

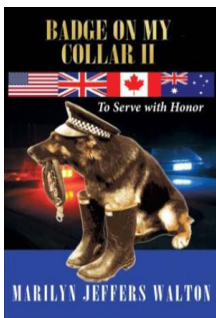
Badge On My Collar *A Chronicle of Courageous Canines*

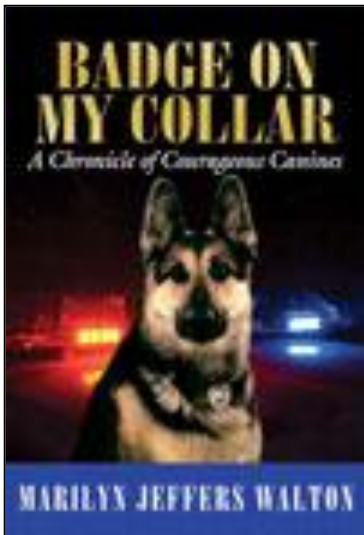

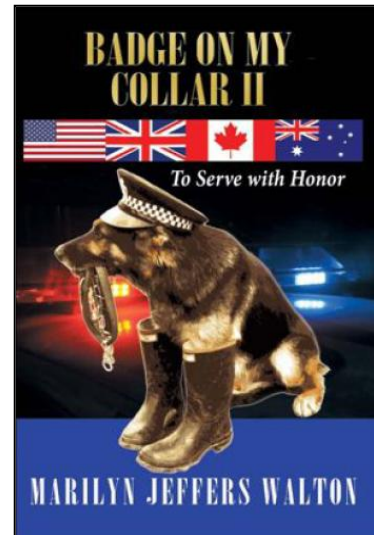
